

Centene's Massachusetts Subsidiary Awarded Medicaid Contract In Five Regions - Sep 20, 2013

Under the contract, CeliCare will provide comprehensive healthcare services for eligible non-pregnant Medicaid adults in the Northern, Greater Boston, Southern, Central and Western regions. Services will include medical, behavioral health, dental, vision, pharmacy, therapies and transportation.
